



FOUND KITTENS?

If you found kittens, here's what to do:

START HERE:

Are the kittens injured or critically sick?

YES

Take them to a reputable shelter.

NO

ESTIMATE THE AGE OF THE KITTENS



0-2 WEEKS OLD
Eyes closed or barely open



2-4 WEEKS OLD
Eyes open and alert, becoming mobile



4-6 WEEKS OLD
Very mobile and often talkative, can eat food



6-8 WEEKS OLD
Very active and playful; around 1-2 pounds



8+ WEEKS OLD
Very active and playful; 2 pounds or more

STOP!

Can you see the mom cat OR a nest?

GET THEM FIXED & FIND THEM HOMES

Get the kittens and mom cat spayed/neutered. If the kittens are friendly, post on social media to find them homes. Or foster them yourself!

DON'T KITTEN-NAP

A kitten's best chance of survival is with mom. Leave the kittens where they are.

Make sure mom has access to shelter, food and water. Contact a TNR group to have mom and kittens spayed/neutered when ready.

ARE YOU SURE?

Mom may be off hunting or hiding. Wait for her return for a few hours.

TIP: Leave a ring of flour around the kittens to check for mom's paw prints!
